## **Round 3**

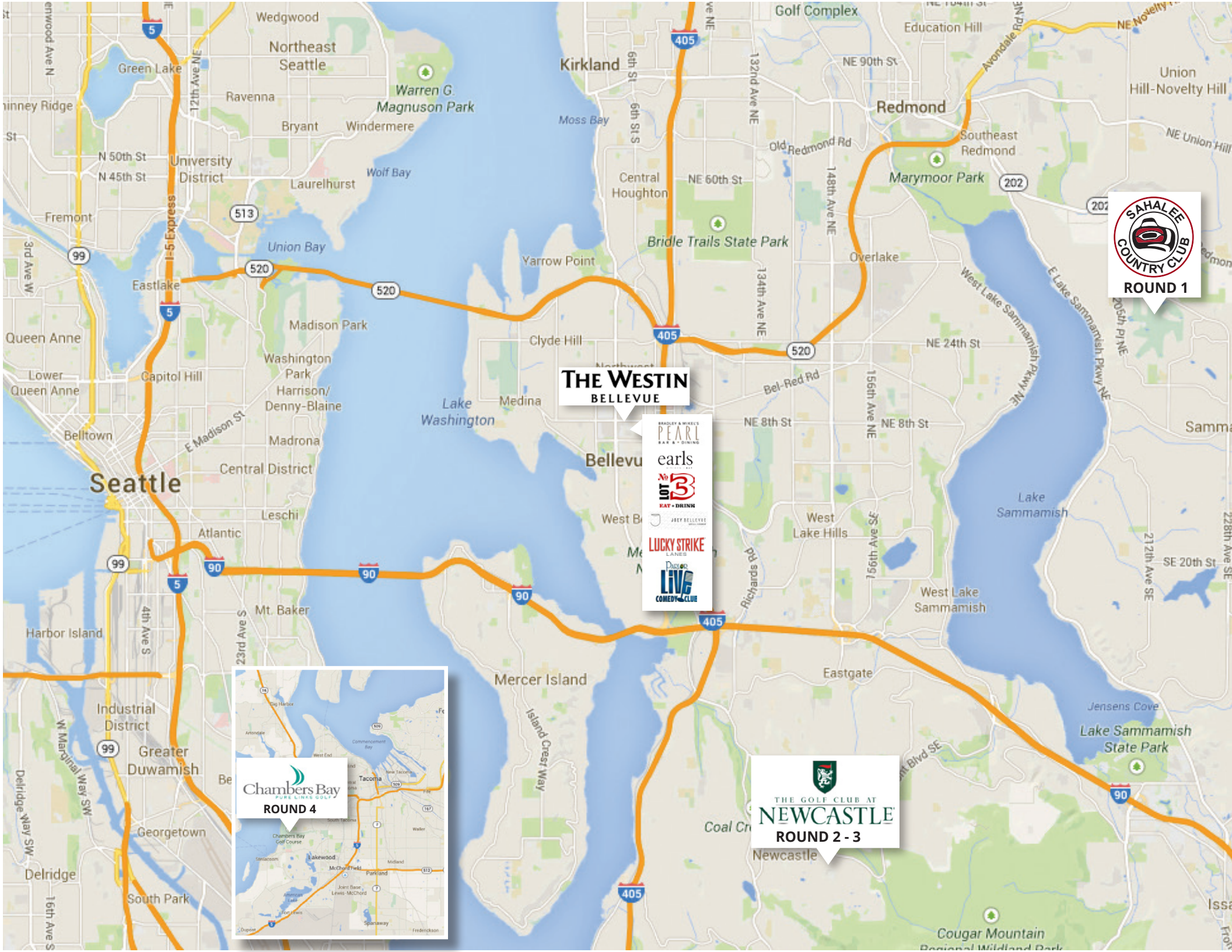

Total handicaps determined by adding the 2 teammates indexes together. The low team total will be subtracted off the high team total to determine the number of shots for the high team. The number will be multiplied by 33% (.5 and up will be rounded up, .4 and below rounded down.)
